



EQUALITY O'CLOCK



Welcome fellow craftivist! Operation Equality O'clock is an opportunity to uplift the Equal Rights Amendment. Centralizing a clock as the common theme highlights how it has been 100 years since the amendment was first introduced, how long Americans have waited for 38 states to ratify the Equal Rights Amendment, and that imposing a deadline for the first time ever violates the Article V process to amend the constitution.

How to participate? Below is one method, but let your creativity guide your expression to build on the central idea of a clock. Fiber arts, visual arts, pottery, found art, or whatever medium illustrates your message that there is no deadline on equality.

Time is now Clock Supplies:

- ✓ Markers
- ✓ Clock
- ✓ Rubbing alcohol

Acquire a clock (online, resale, retail). Gather your markers. Acrylic paint markers seemed to work best. Have rubbing alcohol on-hand to remove unwanted paint from the clock. Plan your design. TIP: Test on paper first.



Take pictures of your masterpiece! Remove the battery (no ticking boxes!). Pack up and mail for delivery to Virginia by February 25. Artwork will then be hand-delivered to legislators in March 2021.
